## **Exploring different textures**

Words You Need To Know	
Horizon	A straight line that runs from side to side.
Landscape	A picture of a natural scene.
Layers	Single sheets of material placed on top of each other.
Texture	How something feels when you touch it, for example, smooth, rough, bumpy, soft or spiky.
Collage	Creating a picture by gluing or fixing different materials onto a surface.
Materials	Anything an artist uses to create art.

## **Sticky Knowledge**

Vincent Van Gogh was a famous Dutch artist born In 1853. Vincent van Gogh painted 'Fishing Boats on the Beach'.

There are lots of different things to see and hear at the beach (seagulls, children, boats).

When you glue down a layer of sand or split lentils and then dab on different colours, it looks like a pebble beach.

When you glue blue cellophane or tissue paper, it looks like the sky.

## **Equipment**

Scrap materials
Blue cellophane
Tin foil
Cotton wool
Sand, lentils, rice
PVA glue and spreaders
Scissors
