<b>miracle</b>	An extraordinary event that goes against nature, cannot be explained by science and that Christians believe is caused by God.
<b>heal</b>	To cure or make healthy.
<b>disciples</b>	Jesus' 12 special friends and followers who shared the Last Supper with him.
<b>Bible</b>	The holy book for Christians, made up of the Old and New Testaments. The stories about Jesus are in the New Testament.
<b>Sea of Galilee</b>	Large lake in Israel.
<b>incarnation</b>	God in human form on Earth.
<b>paralysed</b>	Unable to walk
<b>blind</b>	Unable to see.

### Sticky Knowledge

- Jesus had special ability to heal people.
