Key Vocabulary

forgiveness	Choosing to let go of resentment and the desire to seek revenge against a wrongdoer.
The Last Supper	The Last Supper was the meal eaten by Christ with his disciples on the night before his Crucifixion.
The Lord's Prayer	Also known as "The Our Father": prayer Jesus taught the disciples.
crucifixion	An ancient form of execution in which a person was nailed or bound to a cross.
disciples	The 12 followers and friends of Jesus who shared the Last Supper with him.
Peter	The disciple who denied knowing Jesus 3 times.
Judas	The disciple who led guards to Jesus and caused his arrest.
